### BOOKING A PROGRAM

### PROGRAM FEES

\$100 per program hour: Not-for-profit group

\$150 per program hour: Corporate group

Payment is requested at least two weeks prior to program date to hold your reservation, and all but \$10 is refundable. Checks made to the San Diego History Center; cash, credit cards and purchase orders are also accepted. Cancellations are requested no later than two days before the scheduled program date.

### PROGRAM DETAILS

- A minimum group of ten people is required to schedule a Speakers Bureau.
- All presentations are one hour unless otherwise stated.  
Shorter versions are available on request.
- Talks are typically accompanied by a power-point presentation.
- A speaker's podium, microphone and a blank wall or screen to project images may be required. Our speakers will bring their own laptop, projector, or flash drive.
- Speakers arrive approximately 20 minutes before the program start to set up and test equipment.
